



Frostbite Invitational Rule

Rundown

AHA! / USA Hockey rules and regulations shall apply in all cases, unless noted otherwise.

- 1. USA Hockey Registration** – All teams and players, without exception, must be sanctioned and registered through USA Hockey.
- 2. Jerseys** – All teams are required to have both their HOME and AWAY jersey present for each game at the tournament. In the event of a conflict the HOME team will have jersey preference.
- 3. Number of games** – Each team will be guaranteed four (4) games as a part of this round robin style tournament.
- 4. Game Start** – All games will begin after a five (5) minute warm-up period. This time will start after both teams have taken the ice.
- 5. Game Length** – All games shall consist of three (3) fourteen (14) minute periods. A two (2) minute intermission will be given between the first and second period. There will be ice resurfacing between the second and third period of each game. Each team will be given one sixty (60) second timeout per game.
- 6. Overtime** – All round robin games will result in a tie if teams have the same score at the end of regulation. Overtime will only be used during the championship game.
- 7. Tournament Scoring** – A win is worth two (2) points. If there is a tie at the end of regulation each team will be awarded one (1) point. A loss will result in zero (0) points. Final standings will be based on the total amount of points a team earns. If a tie occurs between two (2) teams in the standings it will be broken based off of goal differential for the tournament.
- 8. Penalties** – Fighting and other major penalties may require disciplinary action. This can result in a suspension or even disqualification for the remainder of the tournament.
- 9. Sportsmanship** – Players, coaches, and fans should display good sportsmanship at all times. This can help set an example for future generations and helps provide a better playing environment for everyone involved.
- 10. Weather** – Any weather related issues are up to the discretion of the tournament director.
